This year we are partnering with Chisholm Heights Baptist Church for our Mexico Mission Trip. We consider it an honor to serve together with our brothers and sisters in Christ. Chisholm Heights has been serving in Mexico for close to 20 years. We have taken two trips previously with Chisholm Heights and this year it works out really well for us to partner together again with them.

FAQ

1. How much will it cost?

- This trip will be booked through Expedia instead of a travel agent like we have done in the past, by doing this we should be able to save approximately \$400-\$500/Person, the anticipated cost for this trip will be \$1,300. We do not expect this cost to be any higher, but if it appears to be at the time of booking, we will contact you immediately before booking.

2. What does this cost include?

- This includes airfare from OKC-Ixtapa, hotel, transportation, some meals (most breakfast, lunch and dinner), travel insurance and a t-shirt. This does not include some meals, any souvenirs, cost of any activities on our day off or **any baggage fees**.

3. Where will we be staying?

- We will be staying in the resort town of Ixtapa at a nice hotel, the Qualton Club All Inclusive Resort.

4. Where will we be working?

- We'll be working in the state of Guerrero in the communities of San Jeronimito, Las Pozas and Zihuatanejo, these are all down the coast from Ixtapa.

5. What will we be doing?

- Construction Ministry Team: Like previous trips, we will do some construction work at the Baptist Seminary in San Jeronimito that we partner with. This could include electrical, light carpentry, Sheetrock, painting or other similar work. There is also a possibility that we could do some construction work at a senior adult living facility again.
- Church Planting Team: We'll be working with Wilbur Martinez and assisting him in his new church work. This could involve prayer walking, evening worship

services, and possibly holding a marriage conference while we're there or even something we've never thought of. The key to any and all mission trips is flexibility.

- Medical Ministry Team: We will have a medical doctor, a dental hygienist and several other nursing and medical staff with us. Others will join this team to come alongside and help and this provides us great opportunities to serve the people as we work at mission sites in the area.

6. Isn't it dangerous in Mexico?

- Just like in Oklahoma, there are bad people in Guerrero, and sometimes they do bad things, so we take precautions. Our missionaries never go anywhere alone, even in the resort area around our hotel. While we're on the mission field, we never travel without anyone from the local church area we serve at. We always try to be back to our hotel before dark and we never carry large amounts of cash. We also never go in the ocean above our knees, the ocean is very dangerous. While we recognize that it can be dangerous, we ask "are you called to go?" If you are called to go, there is no safer place to be than in God's will. If you're not called to go, then please do not go.

7. What do I need to do in order to go?

- Pray. Pray to see if God is telling you to go.
- You need to be able to commit to making the payments for your trip, once you commit you're obligated for the full amount.
- There will be a few training sessions before we go, you would need to commit to those sessions, they will most likely be on a Sunday afternoon at Chisholm Heights in Mustang.
- You need a passport, ASAP!
- If you're a minor you need both parents approval, you must have a signed affidavit showing approval to board the plane.
- Most of all you need to commit to be willing to allow God to use you throughout the trip while we serve the people of Guerrero.

8. Registration and Agreement:

- Since we are booking through Expedia, a deposit of \$750 will be due at sign-up to help reduce the financial risk we have as a church. **You must register at the latest by Sunday, April 30th. Flights will be booked on May 1st.** There will be a June 18th payment of \$300 and July 16th payment of \$250.
- Payment is non-refundable and non-transferable, once you commit to go, you commit to the full amount. If you are unable to go on the trip, you are still responsible for the remaining balance of the trip.
